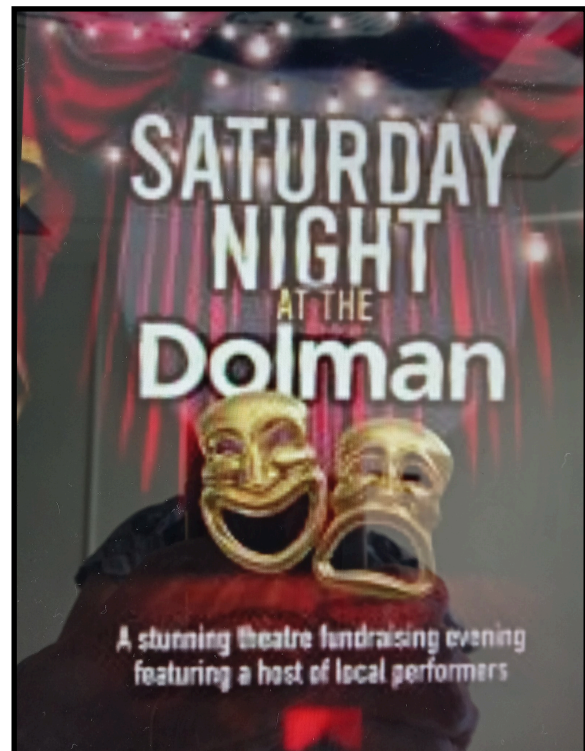


GALA CONCERT
