

The GEOGRAPHY Competition, 2021

The Format for each of the NINE rounds should not take longer than 2 hours. It all depends on the competitors!!.

Round 1 One set of 5 questions, asked separately, to each team.

Each team must choose from one of these six sections – there are two sets, (A and B), in each category -

- 1 The British Isles – general, (towns, cities, rivers, highlands) and infrastructures, (roads, railways, sea/airports)
- 2 Capital cities of the world (exc. UK)
- 3 Rivers of the world (exc. UK)
- 4 Canals of the world (inc. UK)
- 5 Water Areas of the World (oceans, seas, bays, etc.)
- 6 Flags of the World (exc. UK)

(2 points for a correct answer or 1 bonus point available to opponents)

Round 2 This is the General Geography round where each team will be asked 8 questions. There will be two Sets, (A and B), to choose from.

(2 points for a correct answer or 1 bonus point available to opponents)

Round 3 One set of 4 photographs will be given to each team. These will be the same set for each team. Each photograph will have 3 questions to answer. The team works together to answer the 12 questions and have a time limit of 10 minutes to write down their answers.

(2 points for each correct answer. NO bonus points available to opponents)

Round 4 The same type of round as **Round 1** except that the section chosen in **Round 1** cannot be chosen again.

(2 points for a correct answer or 1 bonus point available opponents)

Round 5 Each team will be played 3 or 4 music tracks. Each team will have different tracks. After each track has been heard the team will be asked 2 questions connected with the music's geography.

(2 points for a correct answer or 1 bonus point available to opponents)

Round 6 This is the individual round where each player will be asked 2 questions. The choices can be taken from the following three countries –

- 1 Italy
- 2 Peru
- 3 Nigeria

All questions will (exclude capitals, canals and flags) but will include (infrastructures, trade, resources and tourism).

(2 points for a correct answer or 1 bonus point available to opponents)

Round 7 A video will be shown on the screen and will last no longer than 10 minutes. Teams will be given 10 minutes to answer the 8 questions on the sheets provided at the end of the video. Alternatively, Geographical Artifacts may be used – a different set for each team.

(2 points for a correct answer. NO bonus points available)

Round 8 Either an O.S.Map, (the same map for both teams) OR a photographic selection of famous towers, bridges and natural physical features. The map and selection will both have 8 questions.

(2 points for a correct answer. NO bonus point available)

Round 9 Each team will be asked 10 Geographical General Knowledge questions using their choice of A or B questions, alternatively. There will be a time limit of 30 seconds for each answer and 15 seconds for a bonus.

(2 points for a correct answer or 1 bonus point available to opponents)

In the case of a draw a Tie Breaker question will apply. The team behind at the end of each round will go first. Periodic scores MAY also be given. Each team will be provided with paper, pen and magnifier. All technical equipment will be provided.
