Visit Chartwell, former beloved family home of Sir Winston Churchill. See newly opened family room & Secretaries Room which have never been seen before by the public with newly acquired historic and personal objects that belonged to Churchill.

We have reserved timed group entry to the house but once you have entered your tour is self guided so you can take as long as you wish. The rest of the day is free for you to explore the hillside gardens, the Studio bedecked with Churchill's art work & of course the café & shop.

**Where:** Chartwell in Kent, former home of Sir Winston Churchill.

**Transport:** By coach. **9am Departing Odiham High Street** (Bus Stop outside Fountains Mall). **4.30pm Departing Chartwell**

**Cost:** Please choose which option applies & make cheques payable to 'Odiham District U3A' for the correct amount.

- **National Trust Members:** Coach only **£15**  
(Please ensure you have your current NT cards with you)
- **Non National Trust Members:** Coach & Chartwell entry **£30.50**  
Both prices include a group timed entry to the House.

**Access arrangements:** The car park is 250 metres from the house with access via a sloping path and 24 shallow steps. Those visitors unable to negotiate steps can use the mobility bus, to visit the house which is operated by volunteers. The site is hilly so access may be limited in places.
