On Tuesday 5th September we will meet at the Marine Centre at Wembury, where a warden from the Devon Wildlife Trust will give a talk on the animal & plant life in the marine environment of Wembury Bay. This will be followed by a leisurely guided walk along the coastal path towards Wembury Point.
