3. Minutes of last meeting

The minutes of the meeting held on 4th April 2022 were agreed to be a correct record.

4. Matters arising

- The offer of a discount for the Southport Flower Show was advertised in the Newsletter.
- Janet's name was forwarded to the Minsterley Parish Hall Committee. They had not responded to this nomination at the time of the meeting.

5. Two minute items

Merle suggested that we should consider moving to a two monthly cycle of Committee Meetings with the option to put an extra one in when the need arises. In principle this was seen as a good idea and that it could be instituted from September.

6. Updates:

(i) Membership

We currently have 158 members on the list. Of these 139 are now recorded as having paid their membership in full. Peter will contact those not so recorded with personal emails to ask then to either confirm that they have in fact paid or to pay the fee or to confirm that they have left.

(ii) Finance

The report was received. John has been in communication with the external auditor, Colin Sharp. A minor correction was made in the figures. Peter agreed to keep the treasurer informed of any cheques paid in for membership fees. Merle informed the meeting that from now on the Family History group will be paying for a venue and that this will involved the taking in and paying out of monies.

(iii) Interest groups

- Disappointingly no coordinator has been found for the Gardening group.

(iv) Publicity and U3a brochure

- There was details discussion of the initial design for a brochure that could be used for publicising the u3a and its activities. She reminded us that we would need to secure permission from people in order to use their photos. It was agreed that we should do this via email rather than producing a formal document. - It was agreed that we should consider using posters to advertise events.

7. Open Meetings

Though the vote at the meeting was not in favour of the transfer, it was decided after further discussion to investigate whether parking might be available at the Ark on a Saturday afternoon.
- The Folk group will be asked to make an input.
- Merle will see whether Marko Ivanovic's drone film of walks up the ten highest hills in Shropshire might be made available.
- It was agreed that we may need more display boards and that information about all the interest groups should be available on the day.
