

Family History - Getting Started

- What are you looking for?
- Write down what you know/remember
 - names, dates, stories, memories
- Ask the family - talk to elders
 - start now!!
- Check old family documents, photos etc.
- Create basic pedigree family tree
 - put you or parent as starting point
- Work backwards in time from known facts

Main Sources of Information

- Official certificates
 - record key events of life birth, marriage, death
 - introduced in 1837
- BMD indexes
- Census – every 10 years (1841-1911)
 - address, who lived there, ages, where born, relationship, occupation
- Parish records – baptisms, marriages & burials
 - can date back to 1600s but not full coverage
 - many registers missing or unreadable

Where to look

- County Archives/Record Offices/Libraries
 - census, PRs, BMD indexes (microfiche/original)
 - access to commercial FH websites
- Churches, cemeteries
- Family History societies
- Lots of websites!!

- Lots of papers, notes, ideas, certificates etc.

- First Information Sheet
- Pedigree Chart
- Research log
 - where looked, what found & didn't find
- Consider ring binders for each family line
 - transparent sleeves

Website Search – Can't find someone?

- Use name & spelling variations
 - “soundex”, wildcard
 - search by first name, nickname, relative's name
- Try less information in search
- Check coverage e.g. dates, places
- Census –
 - look for family members
 - address search, neighbours search
 - reverse names in search
 - check census missing pages list

The county's **Family History Societies** are collaborating with the local Registration Services to make the indexes to the records freely searchable via the Internet.

Although the **indexes are not yet complete** for all years and districts, we hope that the database will eventually cover Lancashire births, marriages and deaths from 1837.

UKBMD also has a Multi-Region Search feature which can be used to search several BMD sites in one go if you are not sure of the area that your ancestors were from.

Manchester Registration District
From 20 October 2014 registers for births, marriages and deaths registered before 1915 will be transferred to the Archives at Manchester Central Library from where certificates will be issued. Further registers will be transferred each year such that registers completed more than 100 years ago will in future be held at the Archives. Registers will, however, remain closed to public view. Online orders will be automatically steered to the correct location and the correct ordering address will automatically be inserted in the postal certificate order forms generated by LancashireBMD. If you wish to place an order in person, then you are advised to check the LancashireBMD index first to establish at which centre to place your order.


