

Preston Park u3a Report & Accounts For the Financial Year ending 31st October 2023

The finances of Preston Park U3A are split into two parts; the income and expenditure of the various 'interest groups' that are largely 'self funded'; and the services provided to the general membership, including the monthly meetings, that are funded by the annual membership subscriptions.

At the end of the financial year, we have reported a surplus (income minus expense) of £4,389. Most of this surplus (£3,917) is attributable to the Interest Groups and this sum will be used by those groups in the coming year.

The balance of the surplus (£472) will be added to the general reserve which currently stands at \pounds 8,013.

Our membership has grown this year to over 450 members and this has generated subscription fee income of £6.517 (10% more than the previous year).

However most of our reported income, 82%, came from Interest Group subscriptions and Heritage Visit fees.

Similarly, most of our expenditure is attributable to the interest groups in respect of hall hire, external visit costs and the cost of tutors.

We also paid a net sum of £3034 to the Third Age Trust for the provision of central services covering publications, insurance and IT services.

Independent Examiner's Report to the Council of Management

Responsibilities and basis of report
