ROLE: TRUSTEE

Role Description

Term of office

One year with the right to re-stand for two more years before a one year break before standing again with an absolute maximum of serving for 9 years. Trustees may resign at any time by giving written notice (unless this would reduce the trustee numbers to less than two).

Commitment

Approximately 1 day per month

Overall purpose	To ensure good governance of the charity and compliance with relevant laws and charity and Third Age Trust ¹ reporting requirements. Develop and deliver activities and events that benefit the charity's members and seek always to improve what is done and how it is delivered.
Responsibilities	Attend the Annual General Meeting normally once each year
	Attend all meetings of trustees, normally bi-monthly, take an active part in the consideration of issues and the making of collective decisions.
	Encourage membership of the charity and actively seek new trustees and others to run the charity.
	Promote the u3a movement in the local community and beyond; ensure events are widely publicised; encourage and support a vibrant and enthusiastic u3a.
	Lead working groups established to look into specific issues.
	Provide assistance and give support to other committee members.
	Represent the charity if requested to do so.
