Renewing Your Membership

If you are already a member of another local u3a, you can join Seaford and pay a reduced annual subscription. However, you must complete the membership application form and give the name of your main u3a.

This applies to all new members or members re-joining after a break

If your income is taxable, you may wish your membership fee to be treated as a gift aid donation. Please confirm this on your membership application which will enable this Charity to reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 that you pay on or after 6th April annually.

We ask that members notify the Treasurer if

- You wish to cancel your Declaration
- If you change your home address
- If you no longer pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you. You must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.
