There are a number of iron age hill forts within a

10-mile radius of Seaton, including Lambert's Castle, Musbury Castle and Blackberry Camp. Slightly further afield there are the larger and more imposing structures of Maiden Castle, Woodbury Castle and Hambledon Hill.

This talk with examine how the different types of archaeological investigations and analysis of finds have informed, and in some cases, transformed, our understanding of the purpose, construction and use of these sites.
