- Learn about the garden's restoration and history. Explore its significance as one of the first naturalistic landscape gardens in England and its position in the Thames Arcadian landscape.
- We will have a 90-minute guided tour of Horace Walpole's 'little gothic castle', exploring the history, interiors and stories of its residents.
