

## 18<sup>th</sup> August 2021: Updated Covid guidance for the Roamers

Car-sharing is now supported, although personal preferences must be taken into account: nobody will be forced to do anything they feel uncomfortable with. All the Roamers participating in a walk have a duty of care towards the colleagues with whom they are to share transport and are required to observe the common courtesy of advising them if they **have not been double-vaccinated**. This means informing the walk leader as well as the car driver and other car occupants, or, in the case of the car driver, his or her passengers.

Moreover, the Roamers are required to be familiar with, and follow, the current Covid guidelines issued by the Government. They must also be aware that they join the walk at their own risk, including any Covid-related issues.

For the purpose of contact tracing, a list of all members participating in each walk must be kept for three weeks.
