

Skiddaw U3A has a policy of ensuring all its members have the opportunity to attend the Monthly Meetings if they so wish. At the moment the Committee are aware that not every member can attend and have a scheme so that they do have that opportunity. There are several reasons why members have difficulties, for instance: living in a remote rural area with no car or access to public transport, perhaps a temporary disability resulting in the member not being able to drive, having difficulty walking or problems with mobility, sight, hearing etc. Would you like to attend Monthly Meetings but need and would welcome assistance? Would you be willing to collect and return members to their homes? (please note, this is not a taxi service for all). Mileage costs at the appropriate rate would be paid by the passenger to the driver.

Monthly Meetings are held on the third Wednesday of the month apart from August and December when a Monthly Meeting will not be held. The meetings are usually held in the Crosthwaite Parish Rooms although some are held in nearby village halls.
