 To improve practices & policies that affect people unfairly.


Currently campaigning for a gas and electricity social tariff and better protection for consumers against forced change to prepayment meters.

Local Service

Citizens Advice in South Essex 20,000 clients a year. (Thurrock 2500 clients a year)

Our main enquiry areas are:

- Debt
- Welfare Benefits
- Energy Advice
- Housing
- Relationships
- Employment
- Legal



Local Service

Example cases:

- £2,000 grant from EDF to help clear utility debts
- £37,000 debts, mainly credit cards, incurred during the pandemic, client assisted with bankruptcy

General cases:

- Helping people navigate Council homeless and housing applications
- Help to apply for benefits e.g Attendance Allowance (£68.10 or £101.75 per week)



Attendance Allowance

You need to be over pension age and have supervision and care needs because of an illness or disability.

Need to meet the DWP's 'disability test'.

- 1.attention from another person or
- 2.supervision from another person or
- 3.another person to watch over them



Pension Credit

- 2 parts, Guarantee Credit and Savings Credit. You might get one or both.
- Guarantee Credit tops up your weekly income to a minimum amount.
- Examples £201.05 (Single) £306.85 (Couples)
- Amount is affected by savings and disabilities
- Savings Credit is a small top-up for people who have a modest amount of income or savings. It's only available if you reached State Pension age before 6 April 2016.

Other benefits include:

- State Pension
- Council Tax Support (low income/ on pension credit)
- Council Tax Discount (often 25% single occupier)
- Winter Fuel Payment (born before 26/9/56/ low income)
- Warm Home Discount (pension credit/ low income)
- Energy Bills Support Schemes
- Bereavement benefits
