## Trust u3a and u3a Membership

#### **About Trust u3a**

Trust u3a is an online u3a where you can gain access to u3a.org.uk's learning resources and join the u3a community until local u3as are able to return to normal.

Membership of Trust u3a runs from 1st April to 31st March.

For 2021–2022 the cost is £10.00. If you are a member of another u3a, you can join as an Associate Member at a cost of £5.00.

Please note. If you are joining the online Trust u3a, it does not automatically entitle you to become a member of your local u3a. To join a local u3a you will need to contact them directly.

### Members of other u3as.

When your local u3a starts resuming activities, you will be able to join them but they will charge you their full membership fee. If you join a local u3a you may remain an associate member of Trust u3a.
