Crochet - Improvers

Discover the exciting and varied world of crochet by building on your knowledge of just three basic stitches – chain, double crochet and treble crochet. We will be using these stiches to create different styles of crochet. We will be using both written patterns and diagrams. Also, we will be learning how to do 'Tunisian' crochet and discovering the excitement of expression in 'Freeform'.

I will be working with UK technology throughout to avoid confusion. If you have been using on-line demonstrations, they often use American names of stitches, which are different from the UK. So, brush up on UK terminology. To know the difference, American patterns refer to 'Single Crochet' (sc) and we do not have that stitch name.

I have been crocheting for many years and love it. I want to share my enthusiasm and enjoyment with you.

Things you will need to bring for the course are:

Hooks

- Sizes 2.00 and 2.50 filet work. Sizes 3.00, 4.00, 4.50 and 5.00 general work.
- Tunisian hook 4.00 or 4.50 or 5.00 they are available online, if not locally

Yarn

- A selection of colours in acrylic Double Knitting to share and swop
- A couple of balls of Crochet cotton. Size 10 or 20 some coloured if you have any
- A couple of balls of textured yarn in colour not eyelash

Stationery

- Notebook, A4 Paper plain, lined and squared, pencil, rubber, pen, crayons, ruler
- Folder to keep notes in
- Notions
 - Scissors Stitch markers plastic curtain hooks work as well
 - Darning needles Magnifying glass *if you have one*

Miscellaneous

- Project an item you might like to work on if you have any spare time.
- A problem pattern don't forget that sometimes patterns have printing errors!
- 2 Items for "Show and Tell".
