Patchwork and Quilting - Beginners

Aim

To introduce u3a members to the skills and techniques associated with Patchwork and Quilting using a sewing machine. **Students must bring their own sewing machine.**

Objectives

- To use a rotary cutter, ruler and mat to cut fabric.
- To use a sewing machine to sew fabric pieces together using a consistent seam allowance.
- To use a sewing machine to join 3 layers ie quilt the 3 layers.
- To bind quilted fabric including 'mitred' corners.

These objectives will be achieved by completing 3 projects:

- A cover for an A5 spiral note book
- A tote bag
- A mug rug



Students will need to bring:

Sewing machine, hand sewing kit, machine sew thread, fabric marker pen, A5 spiral bound note book. *More details to be provided later.*

Materials

Each student will be provided with a pack of materials to enable them to complete the projects – **cost of £10**, to be paid to the tutor at the start of the course.

Equipment provided:

Iron, ironing board, spray starch, cutting mat, rulers, rotary cutter, spray glue.
