An introduction to the most intriguing card game that you can play!

This course is designed for beginners who, after this short course, will be able to hold their own in playing a basic game of Bridge. The intention is to inspire you to continue with your studies so that you can join a bridge club in your locality and learn to love the game, as I do! Some experience of other card games would give you a head start.



Learning Bridge is quite intensive, as it is based on constant awareness and counting during the play – but don't be put off – it is also tremendous fun.

It is suggested that a perusal of 'Beginning Bridge' by Andrew Robson, at a cost of £8.00, might be an advantage. The system you will be introduced to is 'duplicate Bridge', based on Acol.

During the course we will cover the essential terminology –

- ❖ hand assessment

- ❖ scoring

You will learn the basic conventions which allow you to converse with your partner using the special secret language of Bridge.

You will be introduced to the equipment used at the Bridge table and to the etiquette of play.

We will progress to supervised play at the earliest opportunity, with help and explanation always at hand.
