Constitution

South East u3a Forum was formally established by a Constitution approved at a Special General Meeting on 21 April 2021, as amended on 25th January 2023, registered at the Charity Commission,

Governance

Trustees are elected from registered member u3a Networks in the South East Region of England, and from the Executive Committee which manages the charity. Trustees are elected annually at the AGM from nominated representatives of the u3a Networks.

Objectives and Activities

The object of the Forum is the advancement of education, and in particular the education of older people and those retired from full time work, by all means including associated activities conducive to learning and personal development in the Forum Area.

Achievements and Performance

The Forum's main activity continues to be the facilitation of a Summer School, currently at the University of Chichester. This year's event saw 151 attendees enjoy eleven different courses. Although one course had to be cancelled after the tutor was unable to attend the event proved very successful.

Financial Review

The Forum made a surplus for the year from the Summer School of £253 which has been added to the Reserves. The Trustees are satisfied that the Reserves held are appropriate to the level of risk inherent in running a Summer School.
