



Health and Safety Policy

Statement

This is the health and safety policy statement of: Stansted Mountfitchet u3a.

Our health and safety policy is to

- prevent accidents and cases of activity-ill health
- manage health and safety risks in our environment
- provide clear instructions and information, and adequate training (if necessary) to ensure members are competent to carry out activities
- consult with our members on matters affecting their health and safety
- provide and maintain safe resources and equipment
- ensure safe handling and use of substances if applicable
- maintain safe and healthy activity conditions
- implement emergency procedures, including evacuation in case of fire or another significant incident.
- review and revise this policy regularly

Responsibilities for health and safety

- 1. Overall and final responsibility for health and safety: Chairman of Stansted Mountfitchet u3a
- 2. Day-to-day responsibility for ensuring this policy is put into practice: Committee and Group Leaders of Stansted Mountfitchet u3a
- 3. To ensure health and safety standards are maintained/improved, the following people have responsibility in the following areas:

All group leaders: safety, risk assessments, consultation with group members, accidents, first aid and activity related health

All group leaders: monitoring, accident investigation, emergency procedures, fire and evacuation

Chair (at General Meetings): emergency procedures, fire and evacuation

Committee/Group leaders: Maintaining equipment (as appropriate), information, instruction and supervision, training.

- 4. All members of Stansted Mountfitchet u3a should:
 - co-operate with committee members and group leaders on health and safety matters
 - take reasonable care of their own health and safety

Arrangements for health and safety

Risk assessment

- 1. Relevant risk assessments will be completed as necessary by committee members or group leaders and action will be taken where deemed necessary
- 2. Review of risk assessments as/when conditions change

Training

- 3. The Committee will give members and group leaders health and safety instruction and provide appropriate training
- 4. The committee/ group leaders will make sure suitable arrangements are in place for members at all activities

Consultation

5. The committee will consult members routinely on health and safety matters, as they arise and formally through policy review

Evacuation

- 6. The committee/group leaders will point out escape routes and ensure they are signed and kept clear at all times
- 7. Evacuation plans at general meetings are updated as necessary
