Hardware are things that can be touched and seen on our computers – keyboard, mouse, touch-pad, touch-screen, screen, DVD drive, side-ports, on-off switch etc. together with those inside the case – processor, memory, graphics-card etc. What do each of these do ? How do they contribute to the computer's specification and performance ?

Software are the untouchables, but essential in operating any computer, such as the operating system and Apps (APPLications) some of which may already be loaded on a new computer, others which we may choose or buy to suit our particular needs or interests e.g. computer language, office software, printer control.

Memory. The computer itself comes with two forms of memory, the working memory (like scrap-paper) used temporarily for noting events, performing calculations ect. and the larger capacity permanent memory on the hard-drive where all software and data created is stored.
