Media. Free downloads of BBC-News, Weather, I-Player, films, sports are available from the Media Centre on your computer. You may also use it to play your own video DVDs and audio CDs. Most newspapers are now available on a subscription basis.

Music can be played on the computer by placing an Audio CD on the CD tray. As with JPEG in photos, music can be compressed into MP3 form and burnt onto a Computer CD – around 10 ACDs can fit onto one CCD then played on some car radios and disk players. Such MP3 files can be copied or moved onto an MP3 player, tablet etc. for use when travelling

Maps. Google maps can be accessed and viewed at various zoom levels, from a close-up street level, out to a remote satellite image. When planning a holiday and booking accommodation on the Internet, such maps are provided on the web-site, allowing you to find a particular location. Such systems can allow you to use your phone on walks or as a SatNav in the car.

Books. The Kindle has introduced us to the electronic book. Amazon provides a wide range of these books, some free others at discount prices – another way of saving your weight allowance on holiday !
