

# Report of visit to ..

## **Sudbury Snooker Club.**

I visited Louise at Sudbury Snooker Club on Tuesday, 18th August.

On my arrival, she 'buzzed' me in, took my temperature and asked me to wash, then sanitise my hands using the wall-mounted sanitiser unit. Masks were not needed. We went through her Covid-19-Secure Risk Assessment which meets all the criteria. Users are asked not to wander about the premises but to stay in the room in which they are meeting. I outlined our Risk Assessment procedure.

She showed me the Function Room which is available to hire during the day, Wednesday to Friday, at £10 per hour. Payment on the day of use. Currently it is used on Monday and Tuesday by Slimming World. The room had been thoroughly cleaned and sanitised, was very clean and tidy.

It is a large room with space for thirty people with social distancing of two metres. There are some large tables, smaller, round tables and one hundred and sixty chairs

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all available for use. I asked whether groups such as 'Book Binding' might be able to use the room, Louise said, 'Yes'.

One of the conditions for use is that users are expected to purchase a drink from the bar .. there was a range of soft drinks, tea, and coffee at £2 per cup. The bar itself is enclosed in perspex, one end open to collect drinks, payment by cash or card. Louise herself would be on hand to serve drinks.

It is my view that this venue could be used by U3A groups without due risk.
