January's Monthly Meeting is on Thursday 18th January in the Community Centre. Doors open 10:45 meeting starts at 11:00.

Dreamflight was co-founded in 1986 by_Patricia Pearce and Derek Pereira, both of whom worked for British Airways. Patricia had previously helped organise a BA project, Skyride, which raised money to take underprivileged children on a one-hour 'Christmas party' flight. Patricia and Derek decided to go one step further and take deserving children to Walt Disney World, Dreamflight was born.

The first trip took place in November 1987. It was originally meant to be a 'one off trip' but has now become an annual event. 197 seriously ill and disabled children are taken to Orlando for 10 days each year without any parents just a huge team of doctors. Nurses, physiotherapists and other helpers to look after them.

Over 6.000 children have experienced their 'holidav of a lifetime'.
