February Speaker Stewart Linford February's Monthly Meeting is on Thursday 15th February in the Community Centre. Doors open **10:30** meeting starts at 11:00.

"The Remarkable Story of our National Chair: The Windsor"

Stewart Linford's passion for woodwork started at school. He studied furniture making and wood science at High Wycombe College in the early 1970s. After graduating from College, he went on to gain a degree in wood science and a distinction for his thesis on Traditional Chair-Making.

As a sole trader he started a furniture-making workshop from scratch with clients that included The Duke and Duchess of Devonshire, The Duke of Marlborough, and Harrods. As a Liveryman of the Furniture Makers Company, he was made a Freeman of the City of London. In 2003 he met the Queen after being awarded her 'Award for Enterprise'.

His speciality is creating chairs to commemorate great British worthies using timbers from HMS Victory to build his Admiral's chair and timber from Blenheim Palace estates to celebrate Winston Churchill.

Today Stewart will give us his highly amusing and original interactive talk on the inside story of the craft of manufacturing Limited Edition Windsor chairs, created to celebrate our British Heroes.
