## HOW TO ZOOM WHAT YOU NEED AND WHAT YOU DO TO PARTICIPATE

Its free to take part. You have the use of a Zoom licence, but its only for 40 minutes if free, otherwise it costs unless the organiser of the meeting has a full licence, like that of our u3a

## WHAT YOU NEED

## a device

- smartphone: iPhone, Android, others all have cameras
- tablet: iPad, Android, others all have cameras
- laptop: usually has camera in lid
- desktop: Apple or PC:
  - if it does not have a built-in camera, to join with Vision you need a webcam mounted on the top of the monitor, connected to the desktop with a cable (HDMI or USB) make sure it is plugged right in, both ends,
- Broadband internet access: or, it is possible using your phone's or tablet's mobile phone network
- you do not <u>need</u> the Zoom app, but its slightly easier if you have it and its straightforward and free to download

## WHAT YOU DO

- Get into your web browser (Chrome, Safari, Edge...)
- Go to the email sent to you and find the link
- Click on the link 5 minutes or so before the start time.
- ullet Click 'Allow' in answer to the question which appears , then  $\to$  notice saying 'waiting for host to start meeting' just wait.
- Notice appears 'Test computer audio' its best to do this the first time (or if you do a practice run)
  - $^{\circ}$   $\,\,\,\,$  'Test Speaker'  $\,\,\rightarrow\,$  click and a tone should sound
  - 'Test Mic' → speak and coloured blobs appear
  - Zoom will probably find Audio and Video automatically on your device
  - if either of these do not function, you may have to go to your device →
     'Settings' → 'Sounds' (however its done on your device) and ensure that the appropriate 'Output sound from the speaker, or 'Input' from the mike, is showing, or Camera is showing 'Video'
- Click the red button, Top Left in the box to return
- when the Host/organiser appears on the screen, click '<u>Join with computer</u> audio'

- At the Bottom Left of the screen are 'Audio' and 'Video' buttons. If 'off', they have a red line across. Click on them to turn them 'on' or 'off'. When people shout 'Unmute' it means that your Audio is turned 'off and you have to click it 'on'.
- Your people will appear in boxes across the screen. Whoever speaks is usually enlarged. Check the angle of your device to get a head and shoulders presentation.
- You do not need much light on you, often you have to cut down the light for the best picture
- That's about all there is folks Enjoy!
