
Thorley U3A Weston-super-Mare *by coach*

Weston-super-Mare has been a holiday favourite for many generations, offering attractive parks and gardens, a golden beach, one of the best piers in Europe, a level promenade, lively entertainment and an excellent shopping centre.

Monday: Departing from local collection points we make our way towards the Royal Grosvenor Hotel in Weston-super-Mare.

Tuesday: An intriguing full day tour starting with a drive through the Mendip Hills to Cheddar, with its magnificent Gorge and home of the world-famous cheese. We continue to medieval Wells, our smallest cathedral city which has been almost perfectly preserved, before returning through Glastonbury, birthplace of English Christianity and supposed burial place of King Arthur.

Wednesday: A full day excursion to Bath, a fascinating city, famous for its hot springs which were first enjoyed by the Romans and then turned into a golden stoned fashionable city in Georgian times. Here there is plenty of time to explore at leisure - don't miss the new spa, the Baths, Pump Room, Pulteney Bridge and the majestic Abbey!

Thursday: A half day excursion to the nearby resort of Burnham-on-Sea, much quieter than its popular neighbour, with a lovely long level promenade.

Friday: Today we say our fond farewells before departing for home.
