





## The Project Screen





#### The Media Screen




The Media Screen shows all the media records you have stored in your Project. These can be Photos, Documents, Census records and items "cut out" from websites e.g. Index data from FreeBMD.

## The Family Tree Chart




The Family Tree is drawn up automatically. However when you start it may not look like this. Again it is something one can modify to meet your own requirements. One can vary the text displayed and add media images to enhance the chart.

#### The Publishing **Function**



Different reports can be produced using the Publishing function. The Report uses the "Facts" data to produce a Word document on individuals or family groups





Data Entry – Select or Create a "Project"





#### The Family Tree Chart - "Out of the Box"




### The Family Tree Chart - As I Like It




#### The Family Tree Chart – How to modify the Chart




#### The Family Tree Chart – How to modify the Chart

#### The Family Tree Chart – moving the boxes




## The Family Tree Chart – Extracting a Head & Shoulders Image


Select "Media" and then the image to \edit. Select "Link to Face" to draw box around the head. Then select "OK".





Tracing the Source of your Data





One can use the "Source" or "Citation" facility to note where one found the source of one's data. I don't use it!

I extract the information from a website and store it under "Media" for all the people it is relevant too. I can also add textual data under "Notes" against that person.
