

Everyone registered to play Table Tennis have been given a Unique Number ID which will be theirs for as long as they are registered to play and are active U3A Members.

Speaking to the players who attend, they have thoroughly enjoyed their time and interaction and are busy getting used to the new rules of Table Tennis.

They are rekindling their long-lost Table Tennis days and brushing up on their skills. Some of the personal Table Tennis Bats members have brought in, have not seen the light of day for more than a quarter of a century, still look in good condition, no doubt it shows how particular they are.
