TECHNICAL OFFICER.

The role of the Technical Officer is to ensure that the audio equipment used for the monthly meetings is in good working order and that the microphones – the lapel radio mics and the ‘roaming’ hand held mics batteries are all OK.

This equipment is stored in the room off the Crystal Suite, together with other U3A items. The equipment is generally inaccessible outside of the meetings due to the number of chairs stored in that room.

In addition to the audio equipment we also have a lap top computer and projector which are used by the various groups.

These are stored at my home and usually picked up from there by the group co-ordinator as required.

The main groups using these items are Photography, Industrial Heritage and occasionally Psychology. (The psychology co-ordinator has our old projector for his group, together with a large screen)

In addition to the above we have our old audio equipment, which is stored in Ian Kimbers garage which comprise 2 stand alone amplifier units, various microphone (wired and radio).

One unit is currently on ‘permanent loan’ to the Folk Dancing group – Pat Robertson (01884 820932) which meets on a Wednesday afternoon at Halberton village hall.

Occasionally, the North Devon Link uses our equipment for their meetings but it is always used in the presence of a Tiverton U3A member and returned immediately after the meeting.
