Obtaining further help with energy affordability

Information from Great Western Railway

Major signalling works in Devon and Cornwall will improve safety and reliability and offer the potential to run more trains. This work will see the replacement of older-style signals and equipment with brand-new, digital technology.

In Devon, the line between Totnes and Plymouth will be closed from Saturday 16 March to Friday 22 March. This will extend to Exeter St Davids over the weekend of 17/18 March as well as after 2140 on most weeknights. Rail replacement road transport will operate between affected stations. We are considering starting a portrait drawing and appreciation group for all levels including complete beginners to experienced artists. Even if you have not drawn anything since school, we would encourage you to come along and give it a try using whatever medium you would like e.g. pencils, watercolours, pastels or of your preference.

There are many reasons why you might enjoy drawing portraits. You may like to capture the essence of a person, to improve your artistic skill or as a therapeutic and meditative activity. Whatever it is, you will find the experience enjoyable and a way to challenge yourself.

At the beginning of each session, guidance and advice will be offered by Chrissie Bennett who has experience of portrait drawing and at the end an opportunity to consider and discuss portraits by well-known artists.

Initially, portraits can be based on photographs, but it is hoped that participants will be willing to rotate as a model for one of the sessions. This experience is a useful one of understanding what it is like to be a model which will have an effect on how to approach your portrait drawing.

It is hoped to run a series of sessions with a small charge for each session to cover the cost of room hire.
