u3a Board of Trustees







## What changes are proposed?

A new u3a representative Council with 2 reps per region/nation and 3 reps from networks to consider u3a matters

A new small u3a Board of u3a members experienced in oversight and compliance








## How will reps be elected?

u3a Council



Elected by Region/Nation or through Network Link

u3a Board



Elected by all u3as

Skills identified by Nominations Committee

Candidates nominated and seconded

### u3a Council Reps will:

- Have a greater voice than at present
- Identify the needs of u3as
- Consider u3a-wide priorities
- Develop and participate in u3a impact assessments
- Encourage participation in initiatives
- Contribute to the overall budget and strategy
- Act as a spokesperson for the u3a movement in their region
- Be key contacts to liaise with other organizations
- Be a conduit for communication to networks and u3as in the region/nation.



### u3a Board Trustees will:

- Have a legal responsibility to act on behalf of the Trust
- Provide oversight of the Trust's performance
- Ensure compliance with charity and corporate law
- Ensure financial integrity
- Approve the final annual budget and strategy



# Is this just tidying up who's responsible for what?

Current Board Trustees have a number of roles:



 As Board Trustees they are responsible for the u3a Trust being compliant

u3a Board


- As lead volunteer in their region or nation, they are the first port of call when advice is needed or things go wrong
- As a representative they keep their u3as informed of discussions and decisions —


### How will u3as be affected?

- No change to local independent operation
- No change to local committee or trustees' responsibilities
- No change to local charity status



# Won't the changes involve more costs?

u3a Council



u3a Council will meet 2x per year online and 2x per year in person

All work groups will meet online

No overall significant increase in meeting costs

u3a Board



Meeting costs have reduced significantly during and after Covid


Board membership would be reduced from 18 to max of 10

Almost all meetings will be online


