

Summary

We will research the architecture of buildings in the following categories :

- medium to large houses which will include manses, hunting lodges, fishery buildings, farm houses
- 'grand' houses such as those belonging to landowners
- schools
- churches
- hotels
- shops

extra innovations such as :

- seaweed factory/bicycle factory/tractor factory/iron workings/cottage industries

'others' such as :

- ice houses/corn drying kilns/lime kilns/stills

To begin with we'll work in small groups and gather as much information as possible (postcards, before and after photographs, information from books, interiors and exteriors, points of interest, designs and plans) and to share with the whole group and the following groups have been allocated : (Group leader bolded)

- medium size houses : Shirley, **Mike**, Nancy & Linda
- schools & churches : **Jeremy**, Janet (with a particular interest in her area) & Sheila (and Sheila has a particular interest in Ardlair)
- hotels, inns & shops : **Dorothy**, Anne & Roger

All gathered information will go into a folder. A booklet will be generated. A1 posters will be the end result for the exhibition.
