New members are welcome to come along to two Speaker Meetings prior to joining to see how the group operates and if it appeals to you. Prospective new members should arrive a little before 2.00 pm in the first instance.

Two Speaker Meetings are held each month where an outside speak will talk on a subject of general interest. There is also an update on our branches u3a activities. The membership fee payable will vary depending on when you join but will not be more than £20 and there is an early bird renewal of £15. New members will receive a New Members Welcome Pack.

Witney currently has around 60 special interest groups covering areas such as Literature with book discussions, Classical Music, Languages: French, German, Italian and







Spanish, Games including Canasta, Bridge and Scrabble, Recreative pastimes including croquet, gardening, table tennis, yoga, and walking. Creative art groups include needlework, photography, play reading and poetry. Other groups include History – art, local history and WW1, Archaeology, Railways, Science and Technology and Wine Appreciation. A great range of subjects with something to suit everyone's interest.

Witney members also have access to our Drop-in Café which is held in the Methodist Church café area on the first Monday of every month at 2pm.
