November General Meeting Yael Shotts was the representative of 'Dementia Carers Count' who gave

an amusing and informative talk in November's meeting.

Many of us were a little apprehensive and wondered what a talk about dementia could be about as it probably has touched many of us with friends or family suffering from one of the hundreds of forms of dementia. However, the subject was about the wonderful charity 'Dementia Carers Count' whose purpose is to support and educate carers as, they say, 'if the carer breaks



down under the pressure, then the patient's wellbeing will also suffer'. (Yael talking to Linda Murphy)

Founded in 1862 as the Royal Surgical Aid Society in London it has gone through various name changes and finally found its focus in 2018 as 'Dementia Carers Count'.

Available for anyone who is a carer for someone affected by dementia, even if it's only for an hour or two a week, they offer support in the forms of a 9-5 telephone service, 24 hour text support, 1-3 day residential courses plus over 30 online learning sessions of which Yael played some to us and they are super informative and a thoroughly refreshing look at a situation that some of us might experience in the future or are already experiencing.

The support they provide was co-developed with experienced carers so they can give help to anyone who wishes or needs to take advantage of what they offer. There are over 700,000 registered carers in the UK who's emotional wellbeing isn't always taken into consideration so what this wonderful charity offers fills that need.

Just a few of their online learning sessions are:- Taking care of yourself as a Carer, The uses and benefits of music, Memory changes, Carers rights and benefits.
