## April General Meeting



Our speaker at the April meeting was Frances Watkins, a medical herbalist, who gave her talk entitled "Modern Drugs Derived From Plants".

Frances trained at Middlesex and then East London University, studying especially tenth century healing plants. She said she aims to teach about plants, especially to children, and explained that herbal medicine depends on getting the dosage right without causing damage or killing you.

With the aid of slides we were shown many plants and herbs and Frances explained their uses and preparation, including maceration and laying down herbs on butter. As little as half a deadly nightshade berry can be enough to kill a child.

Frances said that some plants were grown for use in war zones and are still in use today where modern drugs derived from them are not available. Poppies, so prolific in France after World War One, grew because the ground was churned up and nitrogen rich from the unfound bodies of horses and the fallen.

It was interesting to hear the origins of so many drugs I recognised. Foxgloves for cardiac problems, aspirin from white willow (known for healing for four thousand years), marigolds for poultices and antiseptic, poppies for diamorphine and daffodil leaves for use in cancer treatments. Liquorice for anti-inflammatory properties but can reduce the efficacy of other treatments.

Also don't be hoodwinked into buying from the internet.

Frances was hugely knowledgeable and interesting and many members were interested in seeing her books and documents after the meeting.
